**WAIVER:** (1) In consideration of the acceptance of my application for entry in the above event or class, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property damage which I may have as a result of above named participation. This release is intended to discharge in advance SEEDS and Seek Education, Explore, DiDiscover, Inc. and its agents, board, volunteers, and employees from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in said event or class, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above. (2) I understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during outdoor activities, or indoor activities, and that participants occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries, and/or property damage, as a consequence thereof. Knowing the risks of the particular activity for which the above signed is registered, I hereby agree to assume those risks and to release and hold harmless all of the persons or entities mentioned above who (through negligence or carelessness) might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs or assigns) for damages. (3) It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns. I grant my permission to transport said participant to and from said event when required and hold harmless those assigned to transport. YOUR CHILD MAY COME INTO CONTACT WITH OTHER LIVING CREATURES. Bee stings, tick bites, scratches from plants, and rashes as a result of contact with plants are possible. We will teach your child to identify plants like poison ivy, but they still might touch it! We will teach your child to check for ticks, but they still might get one imbedded.
